Best Time to Visit Egypt

Egypt can be visited year-round, but some seasons are more comfortable depending on your travel plans.

October – April (Best Overall Season)

These cooler months are ideal for sightseeing, Nile cruises, and exploring temples and archaeological sites.

Average daytime temperatures range between **20–30°C (68–86°F)**.

May – September (Summer Season)

Temperatures rise, especially in **Upper Egypt (Luxor and Aswan)**, but this season offers fewer crowds and attractive hotel rates.

Red Sea destinations such as **Hurghada** and **Marsa Alam** remain popular for beach holidays during summer.

Egypt's Top Destinations

Cairo

Egypt's capital is a dynamic city where ancient history and modern life exist side by side. **Cairo** is home to the legendary pyramids, world-class museums, historic mosques, and lively bazaars.

Luxor

Abydos

Abydos was closely associated with the worship of Osiris, the god of the afterlife. The **Temple of Seti I** is renowned for its beautifully preserved reliefs and the famous **Abydos King List**, which records many of Egypt's pharaohs. The site offers a glimpse into ancient traditions and is considered one of the most important pilgrimage centers of the ancient world.

Aswan

Located in southern Egypt, Aswan offers a more relaxed atmosphere and beautiful Nile scenery. The city is known for its **Nubian culture**, colorful villages, and historic temples.

-**Philae Temple** and nearby **Abu Simbel** are among the most spectacular sites in Egypt.

Hurghada

Hurghada is one of Egypt's most popular Red Sea resorts, known for its crystal-clear waters and vibrant coral reefs.

-Visitors enjoy snorkeling, scuba diving, boat trips to nearby islands, and relaxing beach resorts.

Marsa Alam

Karnak Temple

One of the largest temple complexes ever built, **Karnak** contains monumental columns, obelisks, and sacred sanctuaries dedicated primarily to the god Amun.

Abu Simbel

Carved directly into sandstone cliffs along **Lake Nasser**, these temples built by **Ramses II** are among the most dramatic monuments in Egypt.

Temple of Hatshepsut

This elegant mortuary temple, built into limestone cliffs, honors one of Egypt's most powerful female pharaohs.

Currency

The local currency is the Egyptian Pound (EGP). Credit cards are widely accepted in hotels and restaurants, but cash is useful for markets and small purchases.

Tipping

Tipping, known locally as “baksheesh,” is customary in Egypt for guides, drivers, hotel staff, and restaurant service.

Dress Code

Light, comfortable clothing is recommended. When visiting mosques or religious sites, modest clothing covering shoulders and knees is advised.

4


✓ **Wear Comfortable Walking Shoes:**
